Belgian Coast, Belgium and Halle-Salle, Germany - April 16-May 2, 2010

We are going to have the exchange to both places in 2010. Both clubs are in contact with me and are awaiting our visit next year. Both clubs have already planned some beautiful outings for us that are surely going to please us all.

In Belgium we will visit Ghent and the flower show, which only happens every four years, a really stupendous display of flower decorations in the main plaza. We will also visit Bruges, a beautiful, medieval town, not to be missed.

In Halle, the club is planning a visit to Dresden, and probably Leipzig, both with beautiful restored historical sites. Also a visit to a hunting castle nearby is being planned.

As to the approx cost of this trip, it should come in at around \$ 2,500, incl. airfare, travel between the cities, special outings of planned excursions, and club fees.

There is a request by some members to also visit Amsterdam and the tulip show there, which at the time of our visit is at its most grandiose display. All is possible. Be aware though that everything is more expensive during this time.

I have been collecting "earnest money" for the exchange in the amount of \$500.00, made out to Sarasota Friendship Force, mailed to me, which I am holding at the present time.
