July, 1929 – September, 2011

Our dear friend and co-founder of our Sarasota chapter of Friendship Force passed away after many years of chronic illness and the debilitating effects of diabetes.

Although active in many other groups, her greatest love was helping to establish a Friendship Force chapter here in Sarasota in 1989. Some of her contributions were establishing a library in a remote town in Brazil following an exchange there in 1992. She encouraged all of us to donate books which she arranged to have sent. In 1991 she was instrumental in arranging a 6 week visit and housing for 16 teens from Thailand on a special Educational Exchange. She led the way for sponsorship for the Strezev family from Moldova, and made possible a new life for them here. Many Friendship Force members pitched in to help on these endeavors, but it was Marie who was the driving force and initiator of these and many other projects.

Marie spread goodness and happiness wherever she went. Her last visit to us was at the 20th reunion party of FF in 2009. Her smile and cheerful attitude remains with us still. She leaves a legacy of devotion to people and the arts and to learning new things and accepting new challenges. She will be sorely missed.

An amount of \$200 is being donated to the Friendship Force International Legacy Fund in honor of Marie.

Tirana, Albania – September 2012

I have been in touch with the person in charge in Tirana, Albania; we are exchanging E-mails to plan ahead for next year. Here is some preliminary information:

The club is able to take 20-25 ambassadors. In case we have more people interested, they will try and accommodate that, too.

I bought a travel book to find out about Albania; it appears to be quite interesting to visit there and has a lot of interesting history,

It is a beautiful country with picturesque small towns, vast plains, high mountains, nice beaches at the Adriatic and Ionic Sea. The people are said to be very hospitable and friendly. A lot can speak some English, at least a little. Most people are nominally Muslims, about 20% Christians. As you know, religion was ruthlessly stamped out during the long time of communist rule.

The weather should be just fine in September, warm and pleasant.

.After our exchange in Albania, I thought we can visit some other interesting places to the north of Albania along the Adriatic Coast, like Montenegro, Bosnia, Croatia and

Slovenia with old picturesque cities, beautiful buildings etc... We might end up in Vienna to fly home from. All these little countries have airports but... To fly into Tirana,

Albania, I found out that we would have to fly into London, England and pick up a flight with British Air into Albania. There is no problem to fly home from Vienna.

I will have a sign-up paper at our next FF meeting for whoever has an interest in this exchange.

I will try to engage a travel agency from Albania. That would keep the cost down. We would be traveling mostly by bus to all these sites.
