September 5 General Meeting at 7pm at the Waldemere Fire Station

Our September speaker will be Debi Frock, Founder and Executive Director of Ghanaian Mothers' Hope, Inc. a non-profit whose mission is to empower children in Ghana, West Africa, to become future leaders.

Debi began her journey in 2004 when she travelled to Ghana as part of a leadership team from the Episcopal Diocese of Maryland. Visiting a bush village and interacting with children changed her life forever. In 2005 she founded the Ghanaian Mothers' Hope (GMH) to build schools in villages thus allowing older girls to attend primary school.



Since its inception GMH has built a preschool, a primary school and a health center. Currently they are building a new primary school and a residence for nurses. More than 80 teens and adults have travelled with GMH to Ghanaian villages on short-term missions, providing programs in health and wellness, education for teachers and children and also assisting in construction. Under Debi's leadership, GMH has qualified for the Combined Federal Campaign and the Maryland Charity Campaign.

A graduate of Stevenson University with a degree in accounting, Mrs. Frock was honored by the college in 2010 as a Distinguished Alumni. She has also received honors from the National Episcopal Church, the Episcopal Diocese of Maryland and the Ghana Professional Achievers. She is married to Scott Lyons and lives in Sarasota. In between her work travel, Debi enjoys spending time with her 11 grandchildren and singing with the Gulf Coast Community Choir.


Exchanges

Rostov-on-Don, Russia & Yalta, Ukraine- Sept. 24 - Oct. 12th

Our exchange is now full and we have a waiting list if someone should find it necessary to cancel.

We'll start our adventure with a 3-day visit to the ancient and historical city of Kyiv. During our stay, we'll explore the famous Kyiv-Pechersk Lavra (The Cave Monastery) and the beautiful and historic **St. Sophia's Church** (see photo), plus other sights of interest.



We'll then fly to Rostov-on-Don, an industrial transportation hub along the Don River. We'll meet our home hosts for the following week and share their lives and enjoy the sights of their city and surrounding areas.
