Directions to Pinebrook South Clubhouse

Directions using Rte. 75 South:

Take 75 South to exit 195 - Laurel Road, Take a right at end of the ramp onto Laurel Rd. and immediately get into the left hand lane. At the next traffic light, turn left onto Pinebrook Road, (**) and travel about 1.5 miles thru the Edmondson Rd. traffic light past the golf course on the left and lakes, make a little dogleg right and then to the left, go over a small concrete bridge and make the next right turn onto Pinebrook Way. About 3 or so streets on the right side of Pinebrook Way, make a right turn onto Featherbed Lane and the clubhouse is on the left at the end. You cannot miss it. There is ample parking for all. Tel. # is 941-485-6460.

Directions using 41 South:

Take 41 South down into Venice. Approaching Venice, you will go under Rt. 681 bridge, and past the RV dealership, and you will see the Spanish Lakes mobile home community on the left and a Hess gas station on the right almost directly across from it. Across from the traffic light at Laurel Road is a Publix shopping center, if you pass the light you have missed the turn. At the Laurel Road traffic light, turn left onto Laurel Road and proceed East about 3 miles past the Laurel-Nokomis Elementary School, past Albee Farm Road and proceed to Pinebrook Road traffic light and turn right onto Pinebrook Road. Then follow the directions above from (**).
