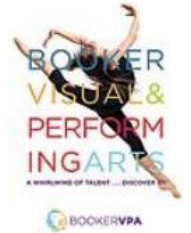


### Sunshine Corner –

- 1 day - Travel to Dresden & sightsee. Overnight in Dresden.
- 2 days - Travel to Prague. Sightsee. 2 nights in Prague.
- 3 days - Travel to Munich. 3 nights in Munich with sightseeing & optional day trips, e.g., day trip to Salzburg, day trip to Castle Neuschwanstein, or morning at Dachau.
- 1 day - Our tour ends. Fly home from Munich.
